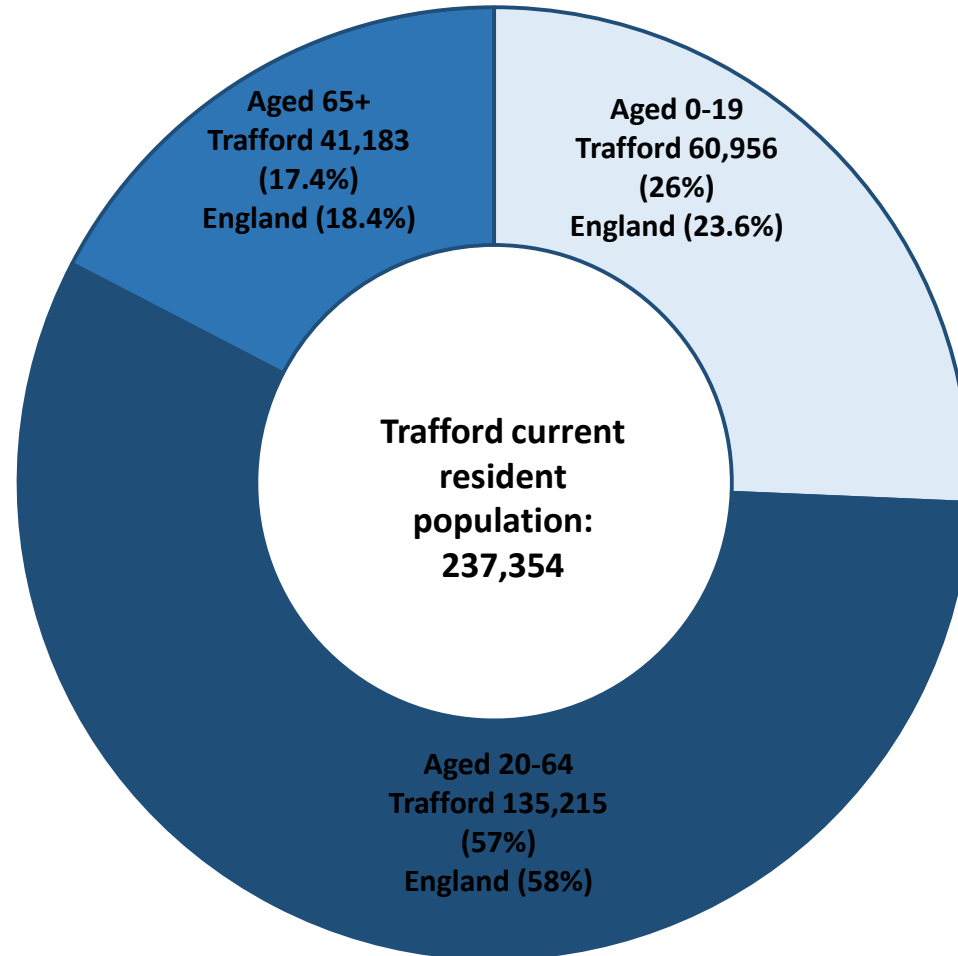

The BAME population in Trafford were found to have a younger age structure than the population as a whole. Among children and young people aged < 20 more than 1 in 5 (21.9%) belonged to a BAME group, compared with around 1 in 20 (4.8%) among those aged 65 years and over (Census, 2011).

Inequalities in Healthy Life Expectancy (PHOF, 2013)

The Slope Index of Inequality measures the range in Healthy Life Expectancy across the social gradient from most to least deprived small areas within Trafford.

statistically similar authorities



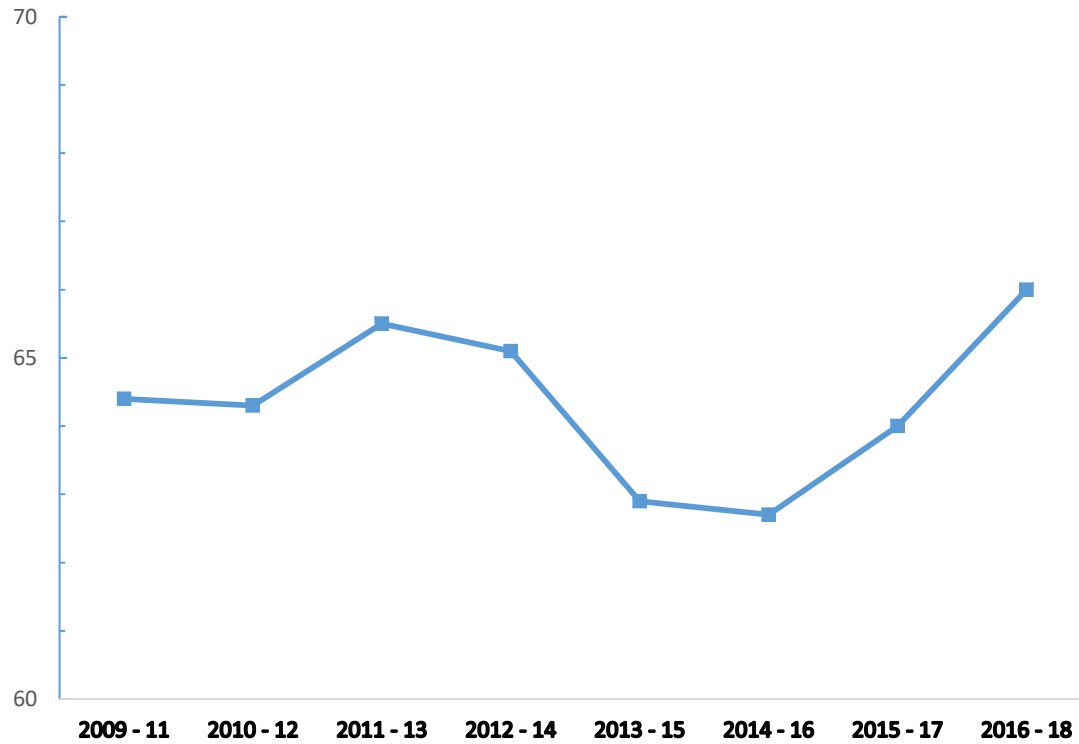
Females = 16.1 years

similar authorities



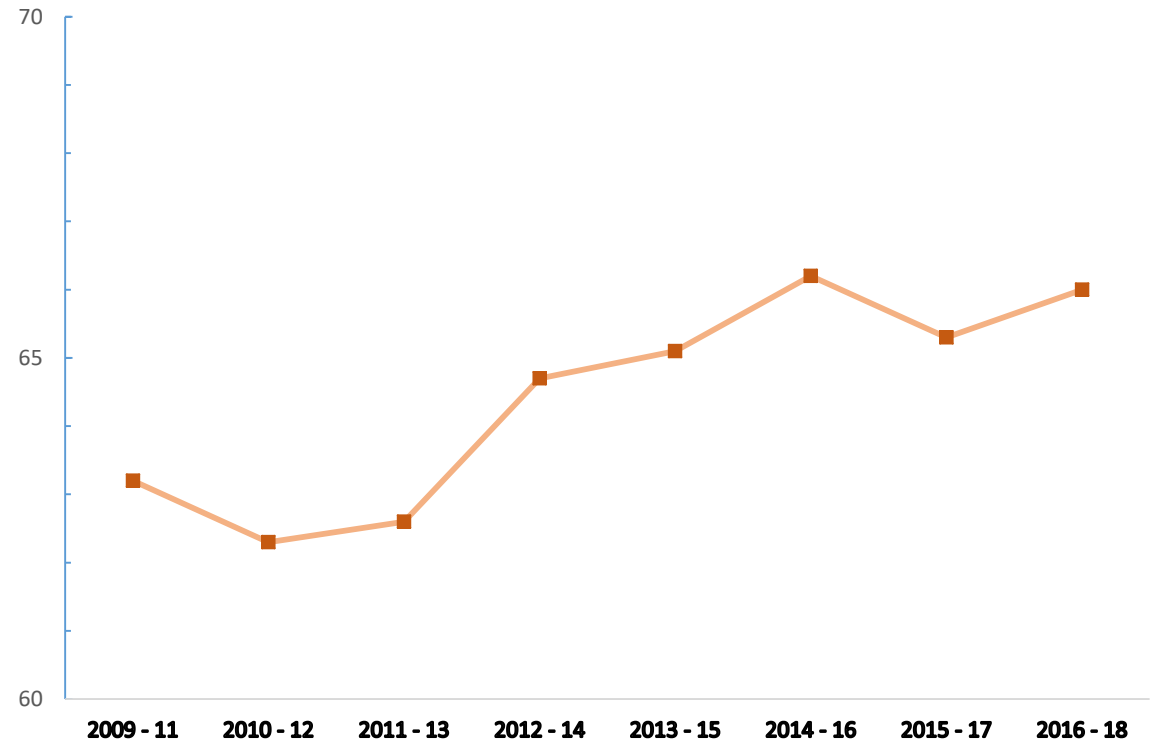

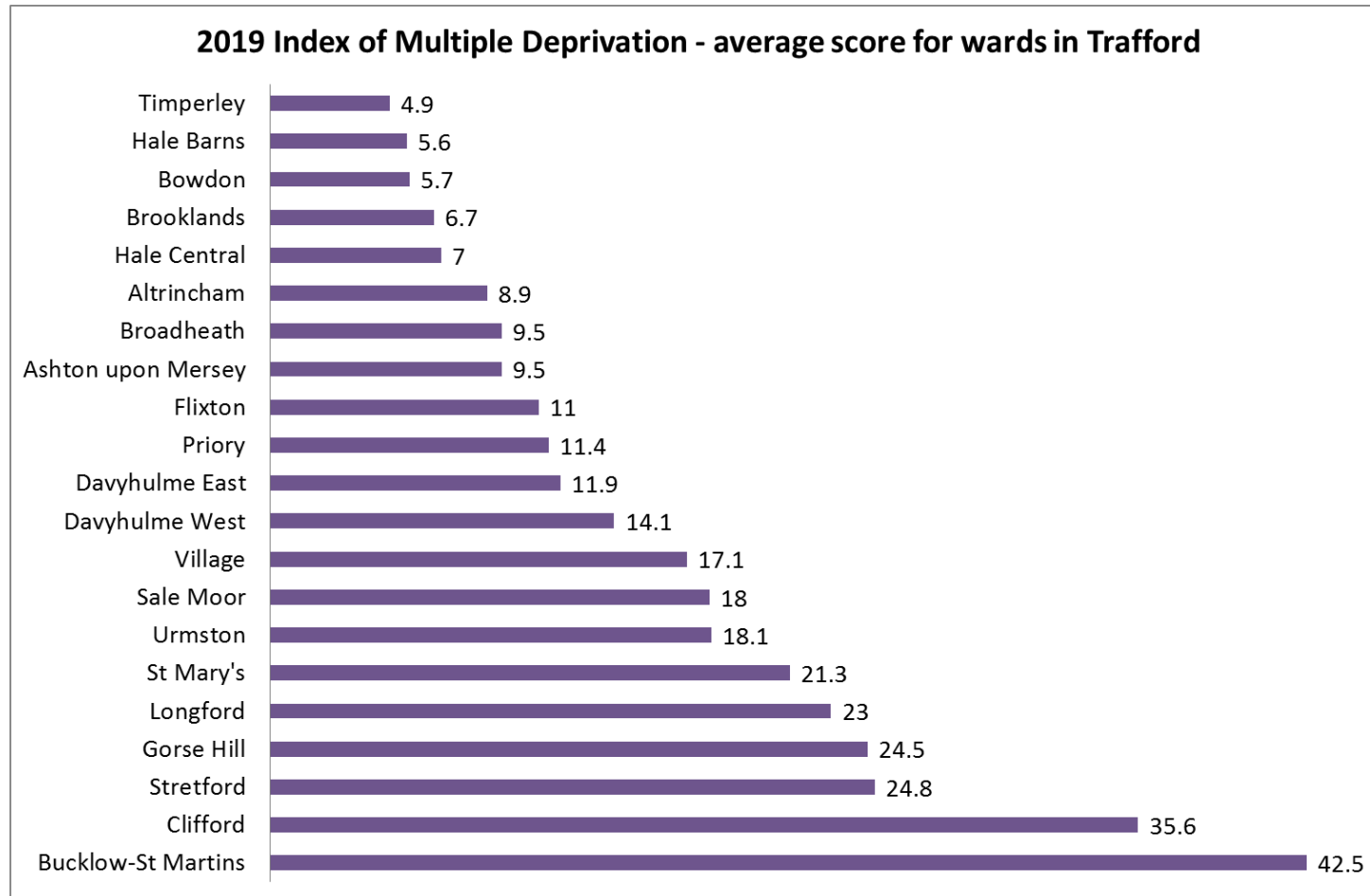

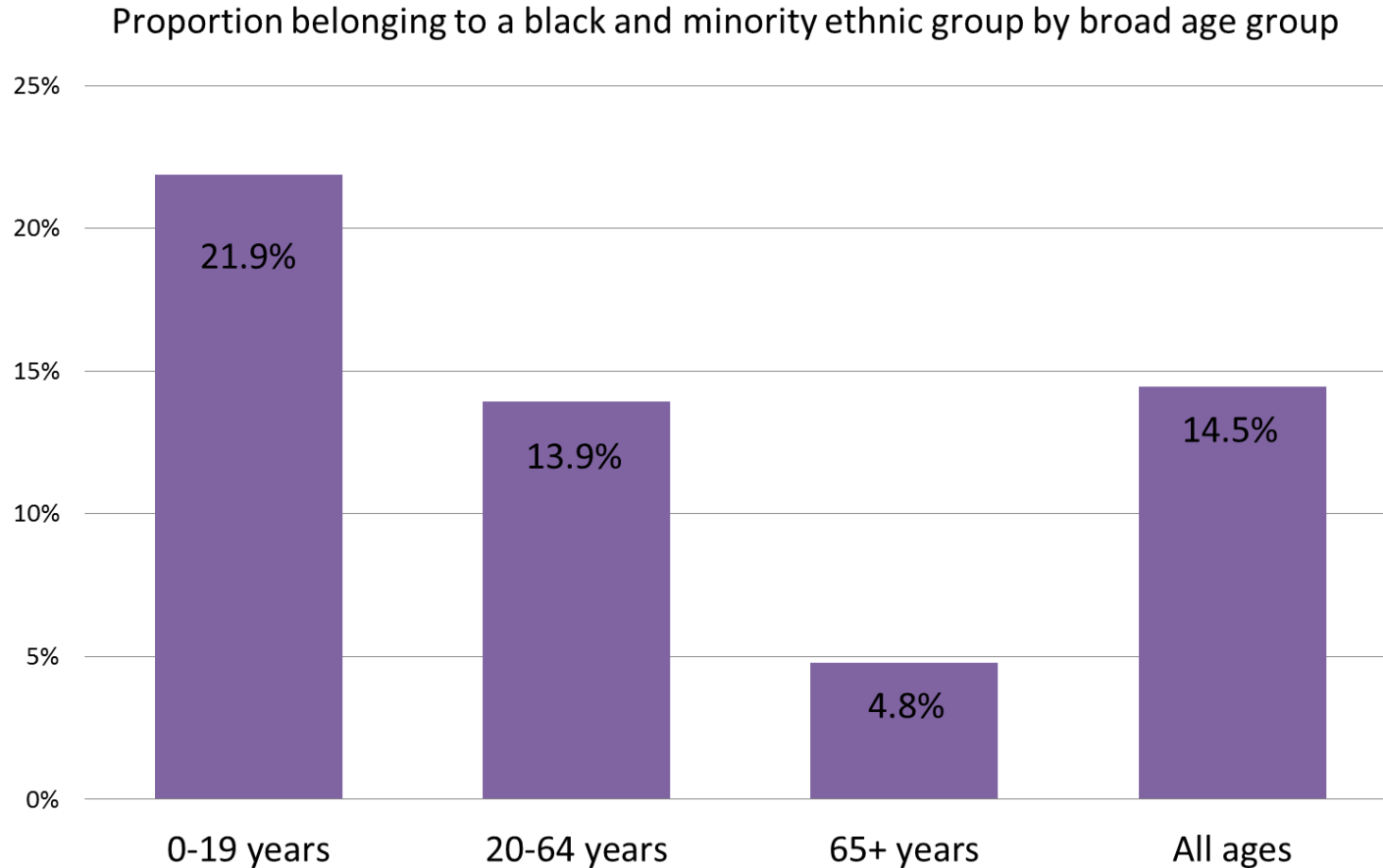
Based on the 2019 Index of Multiple Deprivation (IMD) score, Trafford ranks 191 out of 317 local authority districts in England (1=most deprived)

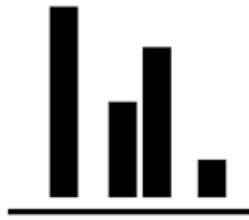

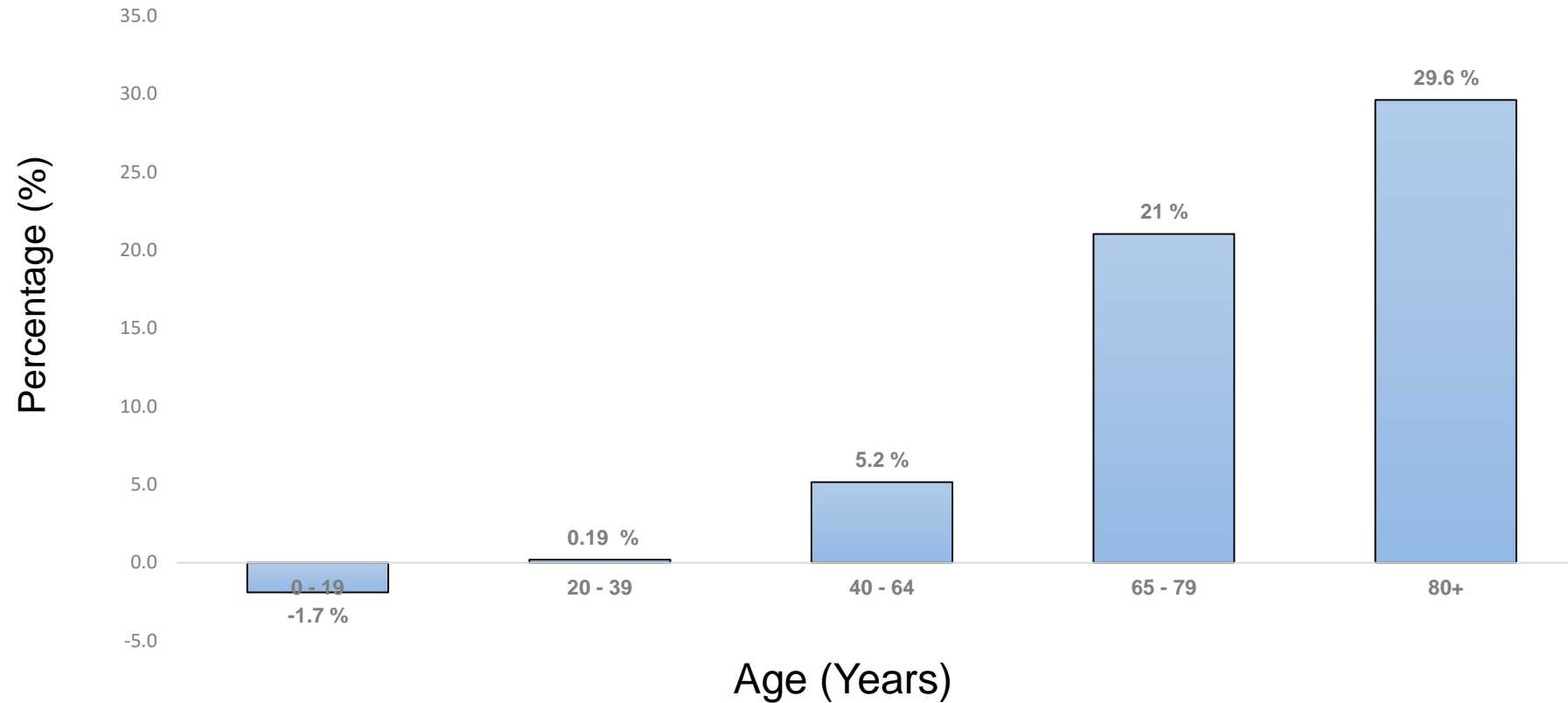

According to broad age group, the number of 0-19 year olds is projected to decrease by 1048 (-1.7%). The number of working age adults in the 40-64 years age group is projected to increase by 4,202 (5.2%). Growth is highest in the over 80 years of age group – a projected increase of 3,638 (29.6%).
