

## **POPULATION ESTIMATES (MID-2019)**






The BAME population in Trafford were found to have a younger age structure than the population as a whole. Among children and young people aged < 20 more than 1 in 5 (21.9%) belonged to a BAME group, compared with around 1 in 20 (4.8%) among those aged 65 years and over (Census, 2011).

# LIFE EXPECTANCY (LE) & HEALTHY LIFE EXPECTANCY (HLE)









Males = 66 years higher than England (63.4 years)





## ETHNICITY




Proportion belonging to a black and minority ethnic group by broad age group

According to broad age group, the number of 0-19 year olds is projected to decrease by 1048 (-1.7%). The number of working age adults in the 40-64 years age group is projected to increase by 4,202 (5.2%). Growth is highest in the over 80 years of age group – a projected increase of 3,638 (29.6%).
